Orientation for 1st Semester

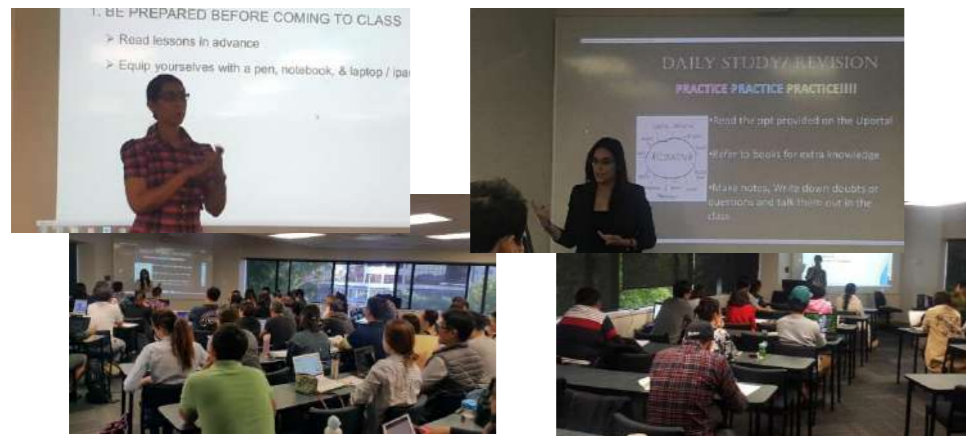

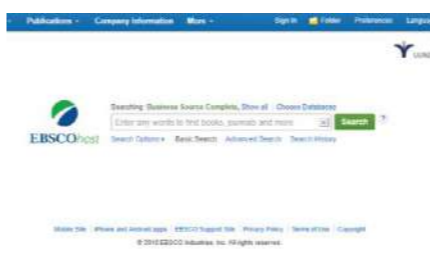

Pilot Training Program



UUNZ is expecting to deliver a pilot training program from July 2018. It is a combination of practical aircraft driving and UUNZ existing courses.
